

Registration fees & information:

Registration for a new September school term opens at the beginning of January. Registrations are accepted in the order received and are non-refundable. You are invited to call for information. All classes are held depending upon enrollment.

After you register:

You will receive confirmation of receipt of your registration. In July you will receive a packet which includes five forms to be completed and returned when school begins in September.

The July mailing will also include tuition information. Select your method of payment (annual, semi-annual, quarterly, or monthly) and return with **First tuition, due August 15.**
